Scrap Metal Dealers Act 2013

- s.1(1) No person may carry on business as a scrap metal dealer unless authorised by a licence under this Act (a “scrap metal licence”).
- s.4 The authority may revoke a scrap metal licence if it is satisfied that:
- the licensee does not carry on business at any of the sites identified in the licence;
 - a site manager named in the licence does not act as site manager at any of the sites identified in the licence;
 - the licensee is not a suitable person to carry on business as a scrap metal dealer.
- s.8(1) An applicant for a scrap metal licence, or for the renewal or variation of a licence, must notify the authority to which the application was made of any changes which materially affect the accuracy of the information which the applicant has provided in connection with the application.
- s.8(2) A licensee who is not carrying on business as a scrap metal dealer in the area of the authority which issued the licence must notify the authority of that fact.
- s.10 A scrap metal dealer who holds a site licence must display a copy of the licence at each site identified in the licence in a prominent place in an area accessible to the public.
- s.10 A scrap metal dealer who holds a collector’s licence must display a copy of the licence on any vehicle that is being used in the course of the dealer’s business in a manner which enables it easily to be read by a person outside the vehicle.
- s.11(1) A scrap metal dealer must not receive scrap metal from a person without verifying the person’s full name and address.
- s.12(1) From 1 October 2013, cash cannot be used by any scrap metal dealer to buy scrap metal. It is an offence to buy scrap metal for cash under section 12 of the Act and there are no exemptions. Only payment by a non-transferable cheque or an electronic transfer of funds will be acceptable. This will mean that the payment will be linked to a readily identifiable account, for both the payee and the payer.
